





FAFSA: The Free Application for Federal Student Aid is the form you fill out to qualify to receive Federal Pell Grant money. **Start at www.studentaid.ed.gov**

The information on your FAFSA application is also used by most institutions of higher education to determine your eligibility for direct student loans as well as other types of financial assistance available.

What is a Pell Grant Worth? If you attend a Title IV school (like us), the maximum Pell Grant award is up to \$6,095 for the 2018–19 school year (July 1, 2018, to June 30, 2019). Grants lower your tuition, so, APPLY NOW!!!
